RE: BEFORE IT IS TOO LATE BY CHIEF OLUSEGUN OBASANJO

- 1. The Ijaw National congress has perused the 18-page letter captioned "Before it is too late" written by our respected former President of Nigeria, Chief Olusegun Aremu Mathew Okikiola Obasanjo to President Goodluck Ebele Jonathan. Not only has he spoken, he has obviously bared his mind by all accounts.
- 2. Even though the Ijaw Nation holds Chief Obasanjo in high esteem for allowing himself to be used as a tool by God for the enthronement of Dr. Goodluck Jonathan, first as Vice President and later President of Nigeria, we are constrained to state our displeasure over the highly subversive motive of the letter he has written and dis-ingeniously leaked to the press. We take very strong exception to Chief Obasanjo's attempt to present himself as the all-knowing and only wise leader in Nigeria from whom President Jonathan must receive lectures on how to run the affairs of the Country.
